To be eligible for this Scholarship you **MUST**:

- Be a full-time student at an accredited institution of learning (i.e. college, university, or accredited trade/vocational school) (College seniors & graduate students are NOT eligible) OR
- Be a High School Senior, College Freshman, Sophomore, or Junior.
- Be directly affiliated with the following Orthodox community churches: St. Nicholas, St. Demetrios, Sts. Mary Magdalene & Markella and the Cathedral of the Annunciation.
- Extra consideration will be given to members in good standing of Baltimore metropolitan AHEPA communities, Daughters of Penelope, Sons of Pericles or Maids of Athena.
- Special consideration will be made for financial need applicants if they are not associated with the Lord Baltimore Chapter
- If applying out of Financial need you must have a minimum GPA of 2.5
- If applying out of Scholastic merit you must have a minimum GPA of 3.0
- Your sponsor must be in good standing. This means that they must have paid all of their Chapter,
 District and National per capita dues by 12/31/2023. The Applicant's sponsor must have been a
 member of the Chapter for two (2) consecutive years prior to the year of the application submission
 date and have attended at least 3 meetings. To confirm eligibility, contact your sponsoring chapter
 officer.

Only one application is permitted per family or household unless applications are due to financial need.

Ensure that all necessary documents below **are included** with your application. **If these are not present your application will be** <u>disqualified.</u>
